1. To submit your application, you must fill all the established requirements without exception.
2. The Directorate of Immigration of the Guatemalan Institute of Migration has the authority to grant or deny requested visas; therefore, it is not obligated to grant the requested migratory status.
3. Approved visas for foreign individuals do not imply unconditional admission to the territory of the Republic of Guatemala.
4. All information provided in this form is subject to verification by the Guatemalan Institute of Migration.
5. The information requested from the foreign individual should match the passport data, except for information not included in the passport.

Statement: When submitting this application, the guarantor hereby affirms that the information provided in this form is accurate, and that the attached documentation is authentic. They are aware of the legal implications and legal effects of their application and authorizes the Guatemalan Immigration Institute to notify by the means indicated above.

VISA APPLICATION FOR TOURIST OR VISITOR FOR CATEGORY "C" COUNTRIES OR VISA CONSULATED REQUIREMENTS

Submit the application file in a GRAY FOLDER for processing, without strikeouts or alterations

1. Visa Application Form;
2. Original valid passport and complete legalized copy issued by a Guatemalan notary or certification of the complete passport issued by a competent authority or complete copy of the passport legalized by a competent official of your country of origin;
3. In case do not have diplomatic representation accredited in the country, you must present a birth certificate;
4. Original certificate of no criminal or police record, or the corresponding certificate from your country of origin. Certificates issued by your embassies or consulates in Guatemala or another country may also be presented. Or, certificates issued by the country where you have resided for the past two years prior to entering Guatemala;
5. Guatemalan guarantor presenting updated guarantor certificate; If you are an individual, you must present recent proof of income and a bank statement, which reflects the income received during the last month prior to submitting the visa application. If you are a legal entity, you must submit tax returns subject to filing with the Superintendency of Tax Administration for the immediately preceding fiscal year that support your financial activity and prove the minimum required capacity. In both cases, the economic capacity must be accredited according to the number of people to whom guarantees are provided, in accordance with the regulations of the Ordinary Immigration Status Registration Regulations. Legal entities incorporated in the last calendar year, as well as those incorporated in the year of the application, are exempt from this requirement. They must submit documentation that proves their income through a projected cash flow statement that supports the income or investments established to start operations, also including support for their contributions to initial capital, or, where appropriate, documentation that supports their financial movement and proves the minimum economic capacity required.
6. Documentarily prove the reason for travel with hotel reservations and tourist packages, or in the case of visiting a Guatemalan person or a foreign resident, attach an invitation letter issued by the guarantor or by the aforementioned persons, which sets out the reason for travel, place of stay and means of transportation within Guatemalan territory;
7. Proof of payment for visa application.

If the applicant is a boys, girls and adolescents or a person declared under guardianship, in addition to the above, the following requirements must be attached to their application:

- a) Birth certificate with apostille or in accordance with the regulations of the Law of the Judiciary, as applicable. In the case of individuals declared under guardianship, attach the documents verifying this status in accordance with the legal formalities for foreign documents;
- b) Complete and legalized copy of the identification documents of the parents exercising parental authority or legal representation;
- c) Written authorization in a single act or separately from the parents exercising parental authority or legal representation, duly apostilled or with the legal passes regulated in the Law of the Judicial Branch or the certification of the file of the execution of the foreign sentence carried out in Guatemala, authorizing the Guatemalan guarantor to manage the visa application process for the child or adolescent or person in a state of interdiction before the Guatemalan Migration Institute;

OBSERVATIONS:

1. **FOREIGNER IDENTIFICATION:** If documents are presented where the foreigner is identified by multiple names, you must attach legal documentation issued by the appropriate authority that verifies the identity of the foreigner.
2. **GUATEMALAN GUARANTOR:** They cannot simultaneously guarantee more than three tourist or traveler visa applications unless they are family members, in which case they must attach the legal documents proving the relationship to their application.
3. **PASSPORT VALIDITY:** The passport where the Guatemalan visa will be stamped must have a minimum validity of 6 months.
4. **MULTIPLE VISA APPLICATION:** Depending on the documentation submitted with the visa application, a legal analysis will be conducted, and if the requirements are met, a multiple visa will be issued.
5. **RECENT PHOTOGRAPH:** Passport-size photo affixed to the front of this form and another photo for visa issuance purposes.
6. **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** The Foreigners Subdirectorates may request additional information or documentation when necessary to clarify, expand, or correct what the visa applicant has submitted.
7. **INVITATION LETTER:** It must be addressed to the Subdirectorates of Foreign Affairs of the Guatemalan Migration Institute.
8. **MIGRATION SERVICE FEES FOR VISAS:** The fee for visa application submitted within Guatemalan territory is twenty-five United States dollars (25.00 USD) or its equivalent in Quetzales.
9. **PRESERVATION AND RETURN OF DOCUMENTS FROM ABROAD:** It is clarified that the documents attached to form files are perforated for safekeeping and custody; if the person wishes to keep them intact, they must be presented in protective sheets. For the return of the originals, if necessary, this must be done in accordance with the provisions of Article 35 of the Guatemalan Visa Regulations, Agreement Number IGM-015-2025 approved by the National Immigration Authority Agreement No. AMN 04-2025.
10. If you change the person acting on your behalf for this application, you must notify the Immigration Subdirectorates through the appropriate procedure.
11. The guarantor must submit the application in person at the Immigration Subdirectorates offices.
